5th Annual Parent Conference

The 5th Annual Parent Conference will be on **Saturday, April 21st from 8:30-4:00** at North Peace Secondary School. There will be presentations for parents of children of all ages. The morning will start with a keynote address by Paula Schmidt. She will be talking about understanding a 21st Century learner. Following the keynote there will be four, two-hour sessions by:

- **Charlotte Diamond** - internationally renowned children's entertainer on how to use songs and musical play to promote language development
- **Dr. Joanne Crandall** - international educator and presenter on how to develop self regulation in children of all ages so they become independent and self assured
