Dear Parents and Guardians:

I have tried it out myself and I could send pictures from my phone and from my computer. Here's what you need to do.

1. **Click** on this link. <https://uploads.picaboo.com/9133802> (I also copied this link address on my phone and it works.)
2. **Enter** your email address. **Select** the Section of the yearbook that you think best suits your picture (Sports, First Day...). I can change this if I want the picture somewhere else.
3. **Click** "I agree" and "I am not a robot"
4. **Click** "Choose Photos"
5. **Select** where your photos are located. Facebook would not work for me so I used the top choice which is "**Click to upload or upload for another source**". This let me find my computer's USB and it also let me choose my phones Picture Library.
6. Select your pictures
7. **Click** "**Upload**" in the top right corner. It will be a blue button. Once clicked, it will begin to upload quickly and you will see a green checkmark that says Uploaded Successfully. That's IT! You don't have to add notes, but that is an option if you want to tell me the name of the child or what's happening in the picture.

Please try this option. It sounds harder than it really is. If you use this link, the pictures will be in the yearbook waiting for me. Last year, I would have to save every text picture I received and then email it to myself and then save the picture to my computer and then upload it to the Yearbook Program. You will save me a lot of time! Leanne
